

INTENSIVE COURSE

An intensive course has become a popular way to obtain a driver's license and works well for many people. The actual training does not differ from a regular traditional education; the difference is that you drive extensively during a concentrated period.

You can plan your intensive course yourself or follow some of our examples below.

15 lessons - 3 weeks intensive education

You have one lesson lasting 70 minutes every weekday for three weeks, from Monday to Friday.

You have the option to complete the risk perception training, known as "riskettan," either before you start your intensive course or during the course.

The skid training, "halkan," is scheduled in advance to be conducted as late as possible during the course.

Total cost 16 400 SEK

20 lessons - 4 weeks intensive education

You have one lesson lasting 70 minutes every weekday for four weeks, from Monday to Friday.

You have the option to complete the risk perception training, known as "riskettan," either before you start your intensive course or during the course.

The skid training, "halkan," is scheduled in advance to be conducted as late as possible during the course.

Total cost 21 050 SEK

The driving test is provisionally booked when your driving instructor deems you ready.

During the course, you will study the theory and complete all the steps of the driver's license tests. If you have any questions, you can find information on our website or contact us for assistance.

Our intensive course is just as the name suggests - intensive. It's designed to provide you with knowledge in a short amount of time. Therefore, you should not expect to complete the entire training or to take a driving test immediately after the intensive course. It's important to be prepared for the possibility of needing more driving lessons if your progress doesn't go as planned. Regardless of the outcome, you will have gained knowledge that might otherwise take several months to achieve.

MORE INFORMATION ABOUT THE INTENSIVE COURSE

Theory

It is advantageous to prepare by studying the theory before you begin your intensive course or during the course to achieve the best results. It's also a good idea to have completed as many theory tests as possible before starting your intensive course at the driving school. This will help you save time and avoid unnecessary stress during the course. Being well-prepared theoretically is a step towards ensuring a smooth and successful intensive course.

Risk education

During your intensive course, you must complete the risk education if you haven't already. The booking of the two-part risk education is done simultaneously with booking your driving lessons.

Riskettan is conducted at the beginning or before you start your intensive course.

Risk Education Part 2 (skid training) is booked as late as possible during the course. If your instructor believes you haven't reached a sufficient level to pass the skid training, the time for that part will be rescheduled.

Driver test

When you reach the end of your training, a training assessment is conducted. The training assessment means that you should evaluate your own driving realistically and assess your own skills to ensure that you become a safe driver.

If you have reached a sufficiently high level to be considered a safe driver and are adequately prepared to pass a driving test, and you have completed all the theory phases, your driving test will be booked. Remember that it is your driving instructor in consultation with you who decides when your driving test should be booked.

Tips and advices

If you have decided on an intensive training, it's important to plan ahead and ensure you have enough driving lessons available. Always have a predictable booking schedule for your additional driving lessons to make your intensive training smoother.

Keep in mind that it's best to book your intensive course approximately 4-6 weeks before the planned start date. Demand is often high during the summer period, which can lead to quick fully booked schedules. So, planning ahead is wise.

Economy

Try to plan your finances so that you have the means to continue with more driving lessons if needed. Remember that you also need to pay the fees to the Swedish Transport Agency (Transportstyrelsen), and these fees are not included in any of our packages.

Fees to the Swedish Transport Agency include:

- Vision Examination (Synundersökning)
- Photography at the Swedish Transport Agency (Fotografering hos Trafikverket)
- Production of Driver's License (Tillverkning av körkort)
- Theory Test (Kunskapsprov)
- Practical Driving Test (Körprov)

Therefore, it's wise to consider and plan for these additional expenses in your budget.

Booking driver lessons

It's a significant advantage if you can drive at any time during your intensive course. Most people plan their courses during vacation periods or summer breaks, so there shouldn't be significant issues with schedules. If you're driving during a vacation, it's a good idea to have some extra time in mind, as you may need an additional week or two.

If it turns out that time is running short, you can continue driving at a more regular pace. The knowledge you have gained won't disappear. If you plan to move or are in Malmö for a limited time, you can also consider continuing your driving lessons at a different location.

In case of illness or cancellation of lessons

Unfortunately, unforeseen events can occur, such as illness or other unexpected circumstances, which may force you to cancel driving lessons. If this affects your training, you should be prepared for the possibility that the scheduled times, such as the skid training (halka) or the driving test (förrarprov), may need to be rescheduled.

We will, of course, do everything we can to assist you in completing your training as smoothly as possible, but the driving school cannot take responsibility for illness or other unexpected events that may delay your progress.

Cancellation - Refund - Course fee

You pay for your intensive package at least 14 days before the start of the course. You have the option to choose whether you want to pay part of the fee or the full amount, but the full fee must be paid before your first driving lesson.

If you cancel the intensive course and terminate the package, you will receive a refund of the amount paid minus 10% of the remaining services and any portion you have used.
